What's an LCA?

Life Cycle Assessment (LCA) is a process to quantify the potential environmental impacts associated with all the stages of a product from raw materials to disposal. LCAs from different analysts and studies should not generally be compared due to inconsistencies in goal, scope, quality and other factors.
